Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) were founded after the signing of the Emancipation Proclamation for the purpose of educating decedents of enslaved Africans. The Historically Black College Alumni, Inc. (HBCA) sponsors the tour for the sole purpose of promoting higher education. Students must submit this application, essay, school transcript and two letters of recommendation from a school administrator and complete an interview. The interview will be scheduled after all required documents are received. Any high school student age 18 and under is eligible. The college tour includes mandatory workshops. Students who fail to attend the workshops may be disqualified from the tour.
